THE GREATEST AMONG YOU MUST BE YOUR SERVANT

Recently I celebrated morning Mass in the parish and still wearing my alb quickly moved on to concelebrate at a funeral in another parish. When I arrived some parishioners half-jokingly said to their parish priest, ah now we have a priest who looks like a priest. My response was simple; and what does a priest look like?

Controversy about clerical dress goes back to 428 when Pope Celestine I took issue with the clergy of France, who distinguished themselves by their attire. The pope argued that learning, purity, and good conduct should mark the clergy rather than their clothing.

Today's Gospel warns against distinguishing dress, taking places of honour and the use of titles. Pope Francis has often warned against such clericalism, clerical privilege and the pursuit of career within the Church. He calls such a mentality leprosy! Over the years I have become increasingly distrustful of people who are dependent on titles. This mentality is of course is not resisted to members of the clergy. I see it not only among clergy but also in our schools where careerism can also be, as Pope Francis would say, a *leprosy!*

In recent years our diocese has seen a proliferation of clerical titles, diocesan honours, with introduction of Monsignors and Papal Knights (NB no Papal Dames!) Such was never promoted by Bishop Kevin Manning. Refreshingly under the leadership of Bishop Vincent we are returning to a simpler Gospel approach, where we are reminded that the greatest must be servant.

We could justifiably adapt the insight of Pope Celestine to our own time: In any ministry, lay or clerical we should be known primarily by the manner in which we welcome and serve others, rather than by what we wear or the title some choose to give us.

They tie up heavy burdens and lay them on men's shoulders, but will they lift a finger to move them? Not they! Everything they do is done to attract attention, like wearing broader phylacteries and longer tassels, like wanting to take the place of honour at banquets and the front seats in the synagogues, being greeted obsequiously in the market squares and having people call them Rabbi.

You, however, must not allow yourselves to be called Rabbi, since you have only one Master, and you are all brothers. You must call no one on earth your father, since you have only one Father, and he is in heaven. Nor must you allow yourselves to be called teachers, for you have only one Teacher, the Christ. The greatest among you must be your servant. Anyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and anyone who humbles himself will be exalted."

National Open Mosque Day



For the third year in a row, a group of MQOF parishioners led by Fr. Peter and accompanied by Bishop Vincent on this occasion, visited the Blacktown Mosque to meet and greet the local Islamic community.

We were warmly welcomed by the mosque leaders and treated to a succinct presentation on the Islamic religion – ranging from basic tenets of their faith to the commonalities of our religions and surprise, surprise..... the Islamic perspective on environmental health! While most of us are aware that Abraham is the revered patriarch of both Christians and Muslims, we were amazed to discover that Jesus is referenced as a prophet numerous times in the Quran! Likewise we learnt that Mother Mary is honoured in the Quran — with the oft-denounced hijab (or headscarf) is worn by Muslim women to emulate Mary's modesty in covering her hair. There were opportunities to ask questions or clarify misunderstandings and the openness to dialogue was clearly evident.

Contrary to a church which is filled with pews and statues or holy pictures adorning the walls, Blacktown Mosque is an unpretentious hall, embellished with Quranic verses in eye-catching turquoise and gold calligraphy, and a simple niche for the imam to lead the prayers. Here we were educated on the essential elements of a mosque and the Muslim customs of worship. What followed afterward was a profound partaking in tradition - Arabic chanting from the Quran on the message of angel Gabriel to Mary, followed by Fr. Peter and Bishop Vincent reading the English version. What a beautiful affirmation of a shared foundation upholding the world's two largest religions, and it timed perfectly with the weekend Gospel reminder from Jesus to "love your neighbour as yourself".

All round an enriching experience and a ground breaking step in fostering religious diversity and community harmony in Blacktown.


