#### THE SACREDNESS OF CHILDHOOD

As we celebrate the nurturing role of Mother's today, it is also good to reflect also on the sacredness of childhood. In these post-royal commission days, the Church has giving added attention to the care of children. On 27 April the Catholic Church professional standards body released a draft statement. The underlying principles of a child safe organisation include:

- creating an environment where children's safety and wellbeing are at the centre of thought, values and actions;
- understanding the nature of abuse and risk factors;
- placing emphasis on genuine engagement with, and valuing of, children and young people;
- creating conditions that reduce the likelihood of harm to children and young people;
- creating conditions that increase the likelihood of identifying any harm; and
- responding appropriately to any concerns, disclosures, allegations or suspicions of harm.

The National Catholic Safeguarding Standards are designed to ensure Catholic Church entities have a child safe culture and practices that are in accordance with legislative requirements, the Australian community's expectations and Gospel values.

The Standards will be implemented by all Church entities to promote a more comprehensive and consistent approach within the Australian Church. These Standards are designed to be applied to all Church ministries in every state and territory of Australia. Every child must be protected by the same rigorous standards.

These Standards apply regardless of where the children live or what part of the Church they encounter, be it their local parish, a Catholic school, welfare or health service, a youth group, a camp, a sacramental program or any one of the many other Catholic services and activities that reach into the community. Consequently the reforms of these post-royal commission days will affect all our ministries.

We hear in the Gospel today the call to Proclaim the Good News to all creation as Jesus ascends into heaven. May we all play our part in sharing the Good News of God's love to others through the advocating of safety and care for all those who are vulnerable in our community.

#### ENTRANCE ANTIPHON: Acts 1:11

Men of Galilee, why gaze in wonder at the heavens? This Jesus whom you saw ascending into heaven will return as you saw him go, alleluia.

#### FIRST READING: ACTS 1:1-11

**RESPONSORIAL PSALM: PS 46:2-3. 6-9. R. V.6** God mounts his throne to shouts of joy: a blare of trumpets for the Lord.

### SECOND READING: EPH 1:17-23

#### GOSPEL ACCLAMATION: Mt 28:19. 20

Alleluia, alleluia! Go and teach all people my gospel. I am with you always, until the end of the world. Alleluia!

#### GOSPEL: Mk 16:15-20

Jesus showed himself to the Eleven and said to them, 'Go out to the whole world; proclaim the Good News to all creation. He who believes and is baptised is saved; he who does not believe will be condemned. These are the signs that will be associated with believers: in my name they will cast out devils; they will have the gift of tongues; they will pick up snakes in their hands, and be unharmed should they drink deadly poison; they will lay their hands on the sick, who will recover.'

And so the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven: there at the right hand of God he took his place, while they, going out, preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word by the signs that accompanied it.
