IS THE INSTITUTION MORE IMPORTANT THAN THE PERSON?

The world of banking and finance, against the will of conservative forces, has been dragged kicking and screaming to a Royal Commission. The ongoing enquiry has revealed numerous incidents of blatant greed, where people have been signed up to debt they could not service. Some finance brokers have been more interested in the commissions and trails than the needs of individuals. Furthermore, we are seeing leadership in the financial world that overlooked corrupt practices for the sake of keeping the good name of their bank or institution.

Today we meet Jesus returning to his home town. As was the custom, also seen in the journeys of St Paul, Jesus enters the Synagogue and begins to teach. Mark tells us that people were astonished, and it would seem, threatened. Did his wisdom outshine that of the synagogue officials and the local rabbi? Was Jesus and his teaching a threat to the status quo? Mark tells us that "they would not accept him". Was maintaining the institution of the synagogue more important than attending to the person of Jesus?

In the past week we have seen a milestone in the sentencing of Archbishop Wilson. The court found that he had been guilty of concealing information of a priest abusing children. As the Royal Commission into Institutional Abuse found, many institutions put themselves before the person, victims and survivors. As has been seen in the five years of the Commission, this was something that our Church often did. Archbishop Wilson has been sentenced for twelve months but how he will serve that sentence is yet to be seen. This is being seen as a victory for victims and survivors of sexual abuse. Concealment is no longer an option for any institution, including our Church. Watch this space, for I am sure that this decision will act as a precedent and we will see others convicted for such concealment.

The recurring biblical truth is that wisdom comes from where you least expect it. God acts in unlikely places and through unlikely people. In decades past, who would have thought that some whose lives had been shattered by abuse, financial or sexual, would have the power to bring to justice previously powerful institutions!

Most of Jesus' ministry was with marginalised people and often in domestic settings. He did not have much time for the institutions of the Temple and the Synagogue. For Jesus, the person was more important that the institution.


