TIME OUT!

Last Friday week I spent the day with twenty six clergy and religious who have come to minister in Australia. It is something I do each year. We began our day at Parramatta, where Catholics gathered, with the permission of the governor, to celebrate Eucharist for the first time in 1803. We took the ferry to the city to visit Church Hill and the excavations of the house of William Davis, the lay man who held the Catholics together for decades in the absence of priests. We then went to the crypt of St Mary's Cathedral and ended our day by looking at nineteenth century Australian art from the NSW Gallery, looking at a new land through European eyes. It was a lesson in being patient with yourself in moving into a new land. Throughout the day I could not but be aware of the ubiquitous use of social media, with conversations reaching India, the Philippines and Africa!

Having had two pre-social media cross-cultural experiences in my own life and over the years living in Australia with clergy from many parts of the world, I have developed a great respect for those who have come to serve our local Church. In my own cross-cultural experiences, as a student in France where I did not have the money for phone calls home and in Uganda where communication was most often not possible, I had to simply live in that place and that time. For so many of our clergy serving from overseas, there is the sense of constantly living in two worlds. They deserve our deep respect!

Today Jesus calls his disciples to go away to a lonely place, something that seems to be profoundly counter—cultural. The same can be said of all of us trying to find a healthy work/life/family balance. In our rush to "get it all done", it's easy to forget that as our stress levels spike, our productivity plummets. Stress can drain our concentration, make us irritable or depressed and harm our personal and professional relationships.

While we all need a certain amount of stress to spur us on and help us perform at our best, the key to managing stress lies in balance. Jesus knew the value of solitude, taking time out, going aside to rest a while. We need such solitude for our health and life/work/family balance. We might even do well to turn off our social media for an hour or two a day to find some TIME OUT!


EXPLORE ALPHA STARTS 23RD JULY


