SEEKING

Reflecting on the short life of Charles Stephenson in preparation for his funeral last weekend, I was struck by the breath and intensity of his reading. His journey through literature, philosophy, Buddhism and his interests in art and music, created a picture of a young man who could be aptly called a seeker.

Anselm of Canterbury, monk, abbot, philosopher and theologian, who held the office of Archbishop of Canterbury from 1093 to 1109, gave to the Church a succinct description for Christian thinking or theology that has stood the test of time. He taught that theology was faith seeking understanding. Now, we place a great deal of emphasis on, devotion and catechism that is, faith and understanding. Less do we focus on seeking.

Today Mark presents us with a community who is seeking to name the person of Jesus. Clearly there was a variety of responses to the personality of Jesus. Jesus does not tell us whom he is but rather asks a question, 'who do you say I am?'

Jesus is good at asking questions. A few weeks ago he asked, when some were leaving his company, 'and you, do you want to go away?' (John 6:67) He invites freedom in our response. Furthermore, Jesus doesn't answer questions. When asked 'where do you live' (John 1:46) Jesus responds, 'come and see! ' Jesus invites us to be seekers.

As the Australian Catholic community moves towards a Plenary Council in 2020 we are being asked to be seekers. I believe this is a moment of Grace for our Church at this time. We are being asked simple but profound questions: what is the Spirit saying and what is God asking of Australian Catholics? The responses to those questions, asked in a variety of groups, will be collated to eventually form the agenda for the 2020 gathering. We are being invited to a process of discernment walking together in seeking.

YEAR OF MARK - YEAR B 24TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON:

Give peace, O Lord, to those who wait for you, that your prophets be found true. Hear the prayers of your servant, and of your people Israel.

FIRST READING: IS 50:5-9

RESPONSORIAL PSALM: PS 114:1-6. 8-9. R. V.9

I will walk in the presence of the Lord, in the land of the living.

SECOND READING: JAS 2:14-18

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:

Alleluia, alleluia! My only glory is the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, which crucifies the world to me and me to the world. Alleluia!

GOSPEL: Mk 8:27-35

Jesus and his disciples left for the villages round Caesarea Philippi. On the way he put this question to his disciples, 'Who do people say I am?' And they told him. 'John the Baptist,' they said, 'others Elijah; others again, one of the prophets.' 'But you,' he asked, 'who do you say I am?' Peter spoke up and said to him, 'You are the Christ.' And he gave them strict orders not to tell anyone about him.

And he began to teach them that the Son of Man was destined to suffer grievously, to be rejected by the elders and the chief priests and the scribes, and to be put to death, and after three days to rise again; and he said all this quite openly. Then, taking him aside, Peter started to remonstrate with him. But, turning and seeing his disciples, he rebuked Peter and said to him, 'Get behind me, Satan! Because the way you think is not God's way but man's.'

He called the people and his disciples to him and said, 'If anyone wants to be a follower of mine, let him renounce himself and take up his cross and follow me. For anyone who wants to save his life will lose it; but anyone who loses his life for my sake, and for the sake of the gospel, will save it.'




