LEADERSHIP THROUGH VULNERABILITY

Across the world, from Russia, U.S.A. to China and from India to Italy and the Philippines, the strongman style of leadership is growing. The macho approach, is driven by rising populism and growing mistrust of democratic systems. The once most powerful country in the world - until now, an exemplar of Western liberal democracies and global stabiliser in times of stress – is ruled by an autocrat who pays little attention to democratic norms. He is but part of a broader phenomenon which is the antithesis of a Gospel understanding of leadership.

The Letter of James asks where do these wars and battles between yourselves first start? James alerts us to the power of ego, which is prepared even to kill in pursuit of its own ambitions. The Gospel of Mark presents us with the disciples clambering for power. Career and clericalism, issues given too little attention in the recent Royal Commission, were there from the beginning of the Church!!

As we make our journey through this year of Mark, we are given a very different model of leadership. Jesus takes a little child, the most vulnerable member of his society. Children before the age of seven had little or no rights in the time of Jesus. He holds up this child as an icon inviting us to experience vulnerability as a prerequisite to leadership.

To the vulnerability of childhood we can add the vulnerability of the aged and frail. We begin and end life

There is no doubt that we Catholics are feeling vulnerable at the moment. In coming months we will be called to participate in the journey towards the Plenary Council of the Australian Catholic community. We are called to a time of humble dialogue, deep listening to one another and what the Spirit is saying to the Church In this process of discernment there is no place for strong man leadership. Rather, we lead through vulnerability.

YEAR OF MARK - YEAR B 25TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON:

I am the salvation of the people, says the Lord. Should they cry to me in any distress, I will hear them, and I will be their Lord for ever.

FIRST READING: WIS 2:12, 17-20

RESPONSORIAL PSALM: PS 53:3-6. 8. R. V.6

The Lord upholds my life.

SECOND READING: JAS 3:16 - 4:3

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:

Alleluia, alleluia! God has called us with the Gospel to share in the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. Alleluia!

GOSPEL: Mk 9:30-37

After leaving the mountain Jesus and his disciples made their way through Galilee; and he did not want anyone to know, because he was instructing his disciples; he was telling them, 'The Son of Man will be delivered into the hands of men; they will put him to death; and three days after he has been put to death he will rise again.' But they did not understand what he said and were afraid to ask him. They came to Capernaum, and when he was in the house he asked them, 'What were you arguing about on the road?' They said nothing because they had been arguing which of them was the greatest. So he sat down, called the Twelve to him and said, 'If anyone wants to be first, he must make himself last of all and servant of all.' He then took a little child, set him in front of them, put his arms round him, and said to them, 'Anyone who welcomes one of these little children in my name, welcomes me; and anyone who welcomes me welcomes not me but the one who sent me.'




