LOVING GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART ... HOW???

As news of the massacre in a Pittsburgh Synagogue broke, killing eleven and wounding six others with rants against Jews and Muslims, we also received the news of Brazil's new president. Jair Bolsonaro joins this group of so called strong men leaders. Commentators have noted that he has a fondness for the country's past military dictatorship. His anti-democratic views are just one element of his disturbing rhetoric, as he freely gives out misogynistic, anti-LGBTQ, and racist statements.

Increasingly we seem to find ourselves living in a culture of hate, with hate speech and hate mail. It is easier to send an abusive text than have a conversation. The present climate appears to be bullying on steroids!

This weekend the Gospel presents us with a profoundly counter-cultural message, love not hate! We are confronted with God's love and mercy, which leads to forgiveness. When we experience the love of God we are transformed and have the desire to share that love and be that love with and for others. This may include putting ourselves into uncomfortable or sacrificial situations. It might mean dealing with situations we are not prepared for and that challenge us. When we truly know that we love God first and foremost, that affects all life, actions and everything we do.

In these weeks 100 families are preparing their children for the sacrament of reconciliation. Children are talking about the Forgiving Father parable in their workshops. God's mercy leads us to forgiveness. These are weeks for reflecting of God's love for our children and their families. Equally they call us to express that love to others, reflecting the healing, mercy and forgiveness of God.

Loving God with all our heart involves loving others and building a culture of love - the very antithesis of the culture of hate that seems on the increase and is reflected in the divisiveness of these so called strong men leaders. How are you going to build a culture of love in your families, workplaces and friendship circles this week?





CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD MARY, QUEEN OF THE FAMILY PARISH, BLACKTOWN

The Children's Liturgy of the Word is the Liturgy of the Word adapted for children. The Children are blessed at the beginning of Mass and then move to their space where the Liturgy of the Word is celebrated at an appropriate to their level of understanding.

The role of the facilitator is to help the children hear the Word of God in a language they can understand, giving the children an opportunity to reflect on God's Word and explore how it connects with their lives.

The children learn about the same scripture reading as the rest of the people at Sunday Mass, taught a simplified message of the readings and encouraged to share them with their parents and families.

Volunteers are needed to teach the lessons each week, as well as to assist with the supervision of the children. This is a great opportunity for adults and high school youth to help these eager young children learn the Word of God.

Children of all ages are welcome to attend. Children's liturgy occurs at St. Michaels Church during the 9.30am Mass and at St Patrick's at the 10am mass every Sunday during the school term.
