Sunday, 2 Dec 2018: First Sunday of Advent - Year C

WAITING, PREPARING AND PARTICIPATING

Today we begin a new year for the Church, the year of Luke. Traditionally we begin with the four weeks of Advent, a time of waiting and preparing for Christmas.

Waiting in an age that values the instant and immediate is profoundly counter-cultural. Some of us are old enough to remember buying a lottery ticket and waiting some weeks for it to the drawn. That has all been replaced by the instant scratchy. Even the trip to the TAB to put a bet on, has been replaced by a bet from your mobile. More and more, if we want something, we want it immediately!

Preparing methodical over time is equally counter-cultural. Good things don't just happen. My own experience over the years of planning to provide for retirement has taught me this. Having a plan and chipping away little by little in my holiday time over the past five years has provided what could not have been there without careful preparation.

Participation in an age given to individualism, can be equally counter-cultural. Our commitment to *welcome*, grow and act necessitates social interaction. It used to be said that there were two things we need to attend to as we age – diet and exercise! Now days, the wisdom is diet, exercise and connectedness!

In some ways these weeks of Advent, with their call to wait, prepare and participate are a microcosm of where we are as Church. For several weeks we have been *participating* in reflection for the Plenary Council 2020. Some two thousand responses have been gathered across the parish. A complete list of these responses is being *prepared*, and will be fed into the national findings. Then we need to wait until after Easter 2019 for the national response before beginning further reflection and response towards 2020.

In a culture that values the instant and immediate, the journey of listening and sharing we are making towards plenary Council 2020, calls for an Advent spirit of WAITING, PREPARING AND PARTICIPATING.

Giving this Christmas

As we focus on Christmas, our minds can easily focus only what our own personal needs are. At Mary Queen of the Family Parish, we seek to *respond to the needs of the family in the Blacktown community and beyond.* There are many ways we can do this at Christmas.

The high point of our spiritual life is (and always will be) the Eucharist as part of the mass. But mass is not available in every Catholic church on every day for a number of reasons, including the occasional unavailability of priests. There is a great alternative on these days. It's a Liturgy and Communion Service and we will have these services more and more as more priests retire.

It's not bad news, it's just an inevitable (and predicted) shift to more leadership by lay people. In some ways it's a shift back to the small gatherings that WAS the early church (prior to the institutionalising of the church under the Roman Empire). When the weekday mass that we attended on Thursdays at St Michaels church building was replaced by a Liturgy and Communion Service, we were understandably disappointed. We attended the new Liturgy and Communion Service and were pleasantly surprised. The service is conducted reverently and is very nourishing to the mind and the soul. A great by-product is the community spirit among the attendees most of whom come to our church every week to share with each other and our Lord. We will always opt for a mass over a Liturgy and Communion Service if the mass option is available.

However, fewer masses is an inevitable trend especially mid week. So there will be more Liturgy and Communion Services and we suggest to fellow parishioners – give it a try. It may (or may not) be for you but we all need to experience a Liturgy and Communion Service at a least few times as they ARE in our future, whether we like it or not.

In the Acts of the Apostles 2:42 we read:

"They devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of the bread and to the prayers."

As members of our Church, we continue this practice of the earliest believers, sharing in prayer and the breaking of bread. You may even love these small weekly liturgies as we do.
