Sin, Repentance, Mercy

During this Season of Lent, there are three themes that have keep resurfacing in our Scripture Readings: Sin, Repentance and Mercy.

The Season of Lent is a time to remind ourselves that we are all sinners. It is certainly true to say that the Church is composed of sinners (the Church Militant - those who are pilgrims here on Earth) and saints (the Church Triumphant - those who faithfully run the race and are crowned with glory in Heaven). Unlike Jesus Christ, we have all sinned. What is sin? Let us look what the Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us about the definition of sin. Sin is an offense against reason, truth, and right conscience; it is failure in genuine love for God and neighbour caused by a perverse attachment to certain goods. It wounds the nature of man and injures human solidarity... Sin is an offense against God... Sin sets itself against God's love for us and turns our hearts away from it (CCC 1849 & 1850). When we commit sin, it affects our relationship with God and with our brothers and sisters.

Since we have all sinned, God calls us all for repentance. It is not a coincidence that Jesus started his public ministry by preaching: "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand" (Matt 4:17). He calls us all to turn away from our sins and turn towards Him. To fully and totally repent from our sins, we need to humbly surrender our sins at the feet of Jesus who died for us on the cross. When we repent, the 'I' in the word 'SIN' needs no longer to be at the centre of our lives but GOD as the focus and centre of our daily existence.

We all need to encounter the Merciful God through the Sacrament of Reconciliation as an essential part of our journey to metanoia (Greek for a "change of mind and heart"). It will be our starting point as we seek for the Mercy of God who wipes away all our sins. This beautiful sacrament is not just about confessing our sins but most importantly it is about a call to conversion - a total transformation of our life. Hence, as we humbly accept the reality of our own sinfulness, we ask for the grace of God who challenges us every time we ask for his mercy - "neither do I condemn you... go away, and do not sin any more' (John 8:11).

What have you to say?' They asked him this as a test, looking for something to use against him. But Jesus bent down and started writing on the ground with his finger. As they persisted with their question, he looked up and said, 'If there is one of you who has not sinned, let him be the first to throw a stone at her.' Then he bent down and wrote on the ground again. When they heard this they went away one by one, beginning with the eldest, until Jesus was left alone with the woman, who remained standing there. He looked up and said, 'Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?' 'No one, sir,' she replied. 'Neither do I condemn you,' said Jesus 'go away, and don't sin any more.'

REPORT ON THE GENERAL MEETING OF THE MQOF PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL HELD ON 21st MARCH 2019

Our second meeting of the year was attended by eight lay members of the Council, Fr Regie, Fr John Paul and Fr Jack.

FORMATION PRESENTATION BY STELLA NWOSU: "The Church of Christ is for Everyone". Stella attended the Conference on 'Growing and Giving life to Pastoral Ministry' She took a lot from the conference and in particular the discussion of the real meaning of applying the Gospel to transform society. We need to welcome and act – to respect others, build bridges, bear one another's burdens. MQOF is a place where pastoral ministers maintain a readiness for dialogue, patience and warmth. A place which is nonjudgmental.

PASTORAL NEEDS OF VICTIMS, CLERGY AND CONGREGATION ARISING FROM CHILD

SEXUAL ABUSE: Paul Scott noted the recent conviction of Cardinal Pell, and raised issues of how we as a parish might reach out to our clergy, the congregation generally, victims and their families. The matter opened up for discussion. A question was raised as to why the Pastoral Letter and statements from Bishop Long were not made widely available. *(note: Please note this letter was already scheduled to be published the following weekend).* The outcome of the discussion focussed on how the Parish should openly show compassion and empathy. A suggestion was made to host a prayer Service or forum where MQOF can come together, listen and pray and heal with victims of sexual abuse and violence.

ALPHA: Fr Regie, Fr John Paul and Fr Jack endorsed the Alpha program at Mary, Queen of the Family. Fr Regie spoke of the importance of entering into a personal relationship with Jesus and Catholic faith.

Action Points from the previous meeting were resolved on the issues discussed.
