GOD'S LOVE CALLS US TO CONVERSION

One of the things that we commonly do is either we call someone or someone calls us. There is always a reason why we are calling and why we are called. In our relationship with God, God calls us always to discipleship—to be detached from worldly affairs and to be attached to Him and His kingdom. He calls us to faithfully follow Him. There are a lot of distractions, which is why we sometimes don't follow the will of God in our life. Like the Gospel Reading this Sunday, we have reasons why we don't answer God's invitation to follow Him immediately. We can sometimes get so easily drawn and attached to worldly values and the devil uses our weaknesses. We must always remember to focus on Jesus, especially in these times, as serving him is a privilege and without him we won't get to where we are meant to be.

In faithfully following our Lord Jesus Christ, one of the things that we have to do is a total transformation of our lives. God loves us so much—there is no doubt about that. But His love for us is a love that calls for a conversion of hearts and minds. To be a follower of Christ, we need to be corrected. Jesus corrects us and we need to listen to him, as we all need to grow into maturity of our faith. Correction is essential.

As community of believers, fraternal correction is necessary in order for us to grow into the best version that God wants us to be. As a priest and as a leader in our parish, I don't mind if you will give me some feedback and corrections so that I can continually serve you as a priest faithfully. Finally, we have the Word of God found in the Sacred Scriptures as our guidelines and instructions of how we ought to live our lives here on earth. With the grace of God, I hope that we all have the humility to listen and to imitate our Lord Jesus Christ who loves us so much and who is calling us to a conversion of mind and heart.



Parish Assistant
