PRAYER AND SERVICE

This Gospel passage has been used by Christians over centuries and centuries to reflect on two aspects of the Christian life: the active and the contemplative life. For most of us, striking a balance between the two is a daily struggle and there can be many reasons for this, some struggle because they find prayer difficult to be motivated for, others struggle because they have never really established a routine of prayer. Yet, there is another reason and that is the pervasive assumption in much of our society that being 'busy' is somehow a good thing. I wouldn't be able to count how many times I've asked someone how they are and they tell me they are 'busy'. This is a tragedy because it means that we have constructed a society where it is normal and habitual to not spend significant time listening to God. We have built a society that has not chosen 'the better part' that Jesus speaks of. There are clues to this everywhere: screen addiction, restlessness, reduction in people's ability to concentrate for long periods of time etc.

But this picture need not be so bleak. As Christians we have a unique role to play in the midst of this society and that is to witness to the importance and the benefits of a life that is lived regularly listening to God's voice, regularly sitting at his feet and contemplating him. The peace that fills the heart of a Christian who is regularly listening to God is actually very attractive to a society that gets lost in its own frantic pace. The light that shines out from these peaceful Christians to their colleagues at school or work or uni, their family members and their friends is something that people long for and this is then our opportunity to speak to them of the source of this peace and light: Jesus Christ.

Indeed, sitting at the feet of Jesus is 'the better part', the 'one thing necessary', and so is the source of all Christian action. First we must sit at the feet of Jesus and learn from him. Then our active life, our life in the world will be touched by his peace and his light. It will have a gracefulness and effectivity that we could never achieve on our own. Do not be afraid to do that one thing necessary and sit at the feet of Jesus. Fr Jack.


