#### **Loving God First**

We have recently completed the 'Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible' program in our parish. I found it very informative as it helped me to understand and value the Sacred Scriptures—the Word of God.

Personally, it was a wonderful experience for me in unlocking the beauty and transformative aspects of the Bible with my fellow members of the Body of Christ—the Church. I am sure the other participants also learned so much about God and His covenant with us and about Jesus Christ and His Church.

During the last session, Jeff Cavins who is an American Catholic biblical scholar powerfully challenged and reminded all of us of our call to become faithful disciples of Jesus Christ. He said that we are not just fans of Jesus but must become his disciples—the ones who must go to all the nations and proclaim the Good News of the Triune God found in the Holy Bible.

To become a committed disciple means to completely give up oneself to God. Jesus clearly tells us in our Gospel this Sunday of what it means to be a Christian Disciple. There is a cost to discipleship. His disciple must carry his/her cross and must accept and put into practise all His teachings. To sum it up, a faithful and committed Christian disciple must love God first of all—his/her family must only come after his/her love to God. Our God wants us to love Him with all our hearts, our minds and our strength. If we truly and humbly love our Triune God, we will also learn how to truly and humbly love othersespecially our family.

Like our Mother Mary whose birthday we commemorate on September 8, let us courageously and wholeheartedly say YES to the call of Christian Discipleship.

'And indeed, which of you here, intending to build a tower, would not first sit down and work out the cost to see if he had enough to complete it? Otherwise, if he laid the foundation and then found himself unable to finish the work, the onlookers would all start making fun of him and saying, "Here is a man who started to build and was unable to finish." Or again, what king marching to war against another king would not first sit down and consider whether with ten thousand men he could stand up to the other who advanced against him with twenty thousand? If not, then while the other king was still a long way off, he would send envoys to sue for peace. So in the same way, none of you can be my disciple unless he gives up all his possessions.'


