Prayer for the sick and housebound: fourth update on changes to the liturgy at MQOF

We have a wonderful and committed ministry in this parish of people visiting other parishioners who are too unwell to make it to Mass with us. There are many who visit people every week, sometimes more than one person, giving up their time and energy to bring Jesus Christ in the Eucharist to those who cannot make it to Mass

For the rest of us, the way we maintain our link with these fellow parishioners is to pray for them at Mass. Currently, we have been doing this in at least two noticeable places. First, in the Universal Prayers, or the Prayers of the Faithful. Every week we have a petition which focuses on those who are sick, housebound or in hospital. The other place we have been praying for them is at the end of Mass with our prayer for the sick and housebound.

It is very important that we maintain this link of prayer with those who would like to be at Mass but are unable, and so we will continue to pray for our fellow parishioners in every Sunday Mass. However, from the 6th December 2019, we will no longer be having the prayer for the sick and housebound at the end of Mass. The reason for this is that this type of prayer is petitionary i.e. it lifts up to God some request of his people. The proper place for this kind of prayer is the Universal Prayers, or the Prayers of the Faithful. It is at this time that we bring before God all the needs of the Church, the world, and our local community in order to be raised up by Jesus Christ to the Father. Since this prayer is for those in our local community, it is fitting to have it during this time and not at the end of Mass where we are to be sent out to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Given that, we will be maintaining a petition each Sunday for the sick, housebound, and those in hospital, but we will no longer be reciting the prayer at the end of Mass.

Again, this in no way diminishes our care for our fellow parishioners, but simply channels this care and this prayer into its proper place in the Mass.





All Ministers in the Parish are invited to attend.




Sponsor a Christmas Lunch


