### **ACYF 2019**

The Australian Catholic Youth Festival 2019 was an amazing and enlightening experience for me representing Mary, Queen of the Family Parish, Blacktown. I was given various opportunities to encounter Christ through the Youth/ Young Adults around me. This pilgrimage to Perth enabled me to listen to and discuss the challenges that are affecting youth especially in today's society. Archbishop Timothy Costelloe SBD opened the festival with these remarks: "As we gather in Perth for this ACYF, our Church, the Lord's Church seems to be in a bit of trouble." Rather than give into hopelessness and despair, we must speak boldly, and not be afraid to make noise and share what is in our hearts to the Church. Just as God called St. Francis of Assisi to "Go and Rebuild my Church", he urged us to do the same and rebuild God's Kingdom here on Earth.

I had various opportunities to attend Plenary Sessions, Workshops and talks on various topics. One of the most interesting for me was a Workshop hosted by the Bishop of Lismore, Bishop Greg Homeing OCD on making God a part of our everyday life. He said that "We are all made to be a dwelling place of God." and "If God is in my life, wherever I go, I bring Christ". As well, Fr Chris Ryan MGL spoke to us during one of the morning Plenary Sessions telling all of us that "God gives us signs about what we are called to do and what he wants to do with our lives." A real moving moment for me was when all the Group Leaders/ Teachers & Priests were asked to stand, raise their hands and pray over all the pilgrims present. The festival provided everyone countless opportunities to receive the sacraments. Reconciliation and Mass were offered everyday. I attended mass in the Syro-Malabar Rite which was a first for me. As well, being able to attend the special Mass, "Missa Terra Sancti Spiritu" or Mass of the Land of the Holy Spirit, with our Indigenous brothers and sisters.

Pope Francis reminds all youth in his Apostolic Exhortation "Christus Vivit": "Dear young people, my joyful hope is to see you keep running the race before you, outstripping all those who are slow or fearful. Keep running. The Church needs your momentum, your intuitions and your faith. And when you arrive where we have not reached, have the patience to wait for us."


