What to wear/not to wear for the Celebration of First Holy Eucharist.

Receiving First Eucharist is very significant in your child's faith journey, ***but we do need to remember that the focus of this celebration is Jesus.***

GIRLS



- ❖ ***White dress:*** Please make sure that the dress is one piece, (skirt and top are also acceptable), covers her back and shoulders and is of an appropriate length. Your daughter will need to be able to walk with her hands together in a prayer position, so the dress should not be so long that she has to hold it up in front in order to walk.
- ❖ ***Simplicity:*** Please don't dress your daughter like a bride or Barbie! Please make sure your child's dress is appropriate to suit the weather.
- ❖ ***In their hair:*** You may choose a simple white ribbon or some flowers if you prefer. ***No tiaras please.***
- ❖ ***No make-up allowed!*** Easy on the hairstyles too.
- ❖ ***No gloves,*** please.
- ❖ If you would like to wear formal clothing from your own culture for First Eucharist please feel free to do so.

BOYS



- ❖ A nice pair of trousers and a shirt (a plain colour usually looks best).
- ❖ A suit (if you prefer).
- ❖ A shirt, trousers and waistcoat.
- ❖ A tie or bow-tie if you would like.
- ❖ No Jeans, Shorts, Cargoes, t-shirts or runners.
- ❖ Easy on the hairstyles too.
- ❖ If you would like to wear formal clothing from your own culture for First Eucharist please feel free to do so.
