Proclaim the Good News

John the Baptist, fully aware of his mission boldly proclaims the coming of Jesus Christ, "Look," he said, "there is the Lamb of God that takes away the sin of the world" (Gospel- John 1:29-34). We, Catholics, are very familiar with this proclamation during the celebration of the Holy Mass, when before us the Eucharistic Lord is proclaimed: "Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world..." He is the fulfilment of God's promise, the Passover Lamb whose blood has been poured out for our salvation. He is the new Moses who leads us into a new exodus from our spiritual slavery into the freedom of the children of God.

St. Paul acknowledged, as a fruit of his encounter with the risen Jesus in the road to Damascus, that Jesus is Lord and Saviour and so propelled him to travel afar to preach the good news. Persecutions and hardships did not stop him from sharing his faith and what he believed Christ can do to humanity. St. Paul had a very deep insight of living a life that evolves in, through and with Jesus Christ and this means everything to him. Therefore, with deep conviction he said, "Woe to me if I do not preach the Gospel!" (1 Corinthians 9:16). His letters are proofs of the truth he lived and believed.

Saint John Paul II wrote, "I sense an urgent duty to repeat this cry of St. Paul. My direct contact with peoples who do not know Christ has convinced me even more of the urgency of missionary activity... But what moves me even more strongly to proclaim the urgency of missionary evangelization is the fact that it is the primary service which the Church can render to every individual and to all humanity in the modern world, a world which has experienced marvelous achievements but which seems to have lost its sense of ultimate realities and of existence itself. 'Christ the Redeemer,' I wrote in my first encyclical, 'fully reveals man to himself. The person who wishes to understand himself thoroughly must draw near to Christ.... [The] Redemption that took place through the cross has definitively restored to man his dignity and given back meaning to his life in the world" (*Redemptoris Missio* nos. 1-2).

The unfolding of God's mystery in the life and mission of Jesus Christ gives us a new understanding of who we are as human beings, and what is God's mission to us and our mission in this world.


