Live a Life with a Purpose!

A few days ago, the world of sports and beyond were shocked by the tragic death of a former NBA star Kobe Bryant and his eight companions including his daughter, Gianna Bryant. As a basketball lover myself, I could not believe the news of the helicopter crash that killed Kobe and his companions. I said to myself 'What a tragedy!'

For those of us who have experienced tragedies and traumatic experiences in life, we will surely find it difficult to accept this kind of reality, like what the families of Kobe and his companions are experiencing at the moment. I can't imagine how they are feeling right now.

Reflecting upon the life of Kobe Bryant, I remembered a powerful statement written in the famous book, *Purpose* Driven Life by Rick Warren: "The greatest tragedy in life is not death but living a life without a purpose." Kobe Bryant, who was not a perfect human being like each one of us, had really lived his life with a purpose—for his family and playing basketball. When he committed a big mistake in 2003, Kobe publicly shared his Catholic faith: "The one thing that really helped me during that process—I'm Catholic, I grew up Catholic, my kids are Catholic—was talking to a priest."

We are celebrating this Sunday, the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. In our Gospel reading, we have Simeon and Anna who knew well that they had a single purpose—to serve our God. They had fully achieved their purpose when they had encountered our Lord Jesus Christ.

Every time we come to Mass, we fully encounter the Messiah whom Simeon and Anna had encountered. May this encounter bring us real transformation in our life and a grace-filled moment so that we can fully and faithfully achieve our purpose in this world.

Sunday, 2 February 2020 Presentation of the Lord

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON: Cf. Ps 47: 10-11

Your merciful love, O God, we have received in the midst of your temple. Your praise, O God, like your name, reaches the ends of the earth; your right hand is filled with saving justice.

FIRST READING: MALACHI 3:1-4

RESPONSORIAL PSALM: PS 23:7-10

Who is this king of glory? It is the Lord!.

SECOND READING: HEBREWS 2:14-18

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION: Luke 2:32

Alleluia, alleluia! This is the light of revelation to the nations, and the glory of your people, Israel. Alleluia!

GOSPEL: Luke 2:22-40

When the day came for them to be purified as laid down by the Law of Moses, the parents of Jesus took him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord – observing what stands written in the Law of the Lord: Every first-born male must be consecrated to the Lord – and also to offer in sacrifice, in accordance with what is said in the Law of the Lord, a pair of turtle-doves or two young pigeons. Now in Jerusalem there was a man named Simeon. He was an upright and devout man; he looked forward to Israel's comforting and the Holy Spirit rested on him. It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death until he had set eyes on the Christ of the Lord. Prompted by the Spirit he came to the Temple; and when the parents brought in the child Jesus to do for him what the Law required, he took him into his arms and blessed God, and he said:

'Now, Master, you can let your servant go in peace, just as you promised; because my eyes have seen the salvation which you have prepared for all the nations to see, a light to enlighten the pagans and the glory of your people Israel.'

As the child's father and mother stood there wondering at the things that were being said about him, Simeon blessed them and said to Mary his mother, 'You see this child: he is destined for the fall and for the rising of many in Israel, destined to be a sign that is rejected – and a sword will pierce your own soul too – so that the secret thoughts of many may be laid bare.'

There was a prophetess also, Anna the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was well on in years. Her days of girlhood over, she had been married for seven years before becoming a widow. She was now eighty-four years old and never left the Temple, serving God night and day with fasting and prayer. She came by just at that moment and began to praise God; and she spoke of the child to all who looked forward to the deliverance of Jerusalem.

When they had done everything the Law of the Lord required, they went back to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth. Meanwhile the child grew to maturity, and he was filled with wisdom; and God's favour was with him.




