### **Gaudete Sunday**

Dear Parishioners!

The 3rd Sunday of Advent is called "Gaudete Sunday" because today's Mass begins with the antiphon: "Gaudete opening in Domino semper" -- "Rejoice in the Lord always."

Today we light the rose candle, and the priest may wear rose vestments, to express our joy in the coming of Jesus, our Saviour.

Today's readings remind us that the coming of Jesus, past, present, and future, is the reason for our rejoicing.

In 1993 I was doing my novitiate in Rome; at that time, I had the opportunity to attend a talk by St. Teresa of Calcutta (Mother Teresa) at the epoch, at the Sapienza University of Rome.

As we know through her ministry in Jesus' name, Mother Teresa brought wonderful blessings and joy to the poor who lay unattended and forgotten on our streets. During her talk she said these exact words expressing the reason and the source of her joy, she said: "Joy is prayer / joy is strength / joy is love / joy is a net of love.

A joyful heart is the normal result of a heart burning with love loving as He loves, helping as He helps, giving as He gives, serving as He serves, rescuing as He rescues, being with Him twenty-four hours, touching Him in His distressing disguise."

With this beautiful example of a saint from our world from our same circumstances I wish that everyone be fill by the Joy of our Saviour and be able to love, to help, and to serve every person in need we meet through our life.

### **ENTERANCE ANTIPHON: Phil 4:4-5**

Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near.

Alleluia, alleluia! The Spirit of the Lord is upon me; he sent me to bring Good News to the poor. Alleluia!

GOSPEL: Lk 3:10-18

When all the people asked John, 'What must we do?' he answered, 'If anyone has two tunics he must share with the man who has none, and the one with something to eat must do the same.' There were tax collectors too who came for baptism, and these said to him, 'Master, what must we do?' He said to them, 'Exact no more than your rate.' Some soldiers asked him in their turn, 'What about us? What must we do?' He said to them, 'No intimidation! No extortion! Be content with your pay!'

A feeling of expectancy had grown among the people, who were beginning to think that John might be the Christ, so John declared before them all, 'I baptise you with water, but someone is coming, someone who is more powerful than I am, and I am not fit to undo the strap of his sandals; he will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing-fan is in his hand to clear his threshing-floor and to gather the wheat into his barn; but the chaff he will burn in a fire that will never go out.' As well as this, there were many other things he said to exhort the people and to announce the Good News to them.

PART ONE: THE PROFESSION OF FAITH

**SECTION TWO** I. THE CREEDS

CHAPTER TWO I BELIEVE IN JESUS CHRIST, THE ONLY SON OF GOD Article 5 "HE DESCENDED INTO HELL. ON THE THIRD DAY HE ROSE AGAIN"

635 Christ went down into the depths of death so that "the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live." 484 Jesus, "the Author of life", by dying destroyed "him who has the power of death, that is, the devil, and [delivered] all those who through fear of death were subject to lifelong bondage." Henceforth the risen Christ holds "the keys of Death and Hades", so that "at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth." 486

Today a great silence reigns on earth, a great silence and a great stillness. A great silence because the King is asleep, the earth trembled and is still because God has fallen asleep in the flesh and he has raised up all who have slept ever since the world began. . . He has gone to search for Adam, our first father, as for a lost sheep. Greatly desiring to visit those who live in darkness and in the shadow of death, he has gone to free from sorrow Adam in his bonds and Eve, captive with him - He who is both their God and the son of Eve. . . "I am your God, who for your sake have become your son. . . I order you, O sleeper, to awake. I did not create you to be a prisoner in hell. Rise from the dead, for I am the life of the dead."487

### IN BRIEF

636 By the expression "He descended into hell", the Apostles' Creed confesses that Jesus did really die and through his death for us conquered death and the devil "who has the power of death" (Heb 2:14).

637 In his human soul united to his divine person, the dead Christ went down to the realm of the dead. He opened heaven's gates for the just who had gone before him.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

#### Re: COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Update

The NSW Government has announced some changes to the reopening roadmap for the COVID-19 restrictions. Based on the announcement, the restrictions will ease further when NSW reaches 95% double vaccination or on 15 December 2021, whichever comes first. For places of worship the following will apply from when the state hits the milestone:

#### **Density Limits**

There will no longer be any square meter rules applicable for Parishes. This includes the Church and other buildings within the Parish.

### Weddings and Funerals

Proof of vaccination will no longer be mandatory. All will be able to attend regardless of vaccination

### Choir and Singing

Singing will be permitted for everyone in attendance.

### Social Events

Parish social events can resume with no person limit.

### Masks

Masks will no longer be mandatory at places of worship. However, this is still strongly encouraged in venues where social distancing is not possible.

### COVID-19 Safe Check-in and Record Keeping

Check in using the NSW QR Code and record keeping of all attendees are still required for places of worship.

### COVID-19 Safety Plans

COVID-19 Safety Plans will no longer be mandatory.

### SACRAMENTAL PROCESS 2021

For Confirmation & Reconciliation postponed until 2022.

On the advice from the Diocese of Parramatta, in conjunction with the NSW government our church will reopen for religious services again, once the 80% threshold of double dose vaccinations target is achieved in the state of NSW.

Unfortunately, we have been also advised that face to face meetings at the parish are not to take place until Stage 3 of the NSW Government's "Pathway out of the pandemic and lockdowns", which is due to take place from the 1st December 2021. Therefore, we are required to postpone the remaining sacramental programs until next year.

We anticipate that the new sacramental dates for 2022 will be available in early February where you will be invited to register your child into the program once again. Please note our registrations will be moving to an online platform, therefore you will need to resubmit your child's application.
