This Sunday marks the last before we commence Holy Week. So far, we've spent some weeks examining our lives, repenting of our sins, making amends through works of charity, and drawing nearer to God in prayer. Perhaps we've been challenged to grow in certain areas, to take to the Lord certain habits that have begun to dominate the way we think and act or certain mistakes that we've made that bring us shame. This is good. It is important for us to recognise our sins and to repent of them, not only because they offend God but because of the damage they cause each of us and the whole Church.

But it is also important not to make sin our whole focus. St Paul proclaimed himself the "chief amongst sinners", the most in need of God's mercy, but in his letter to the Philippians, he tells us that he "forgets the past". This is not because his past wasn't important, but because he had encountered the Lord who tells us through Isaiah, "no need to recall the past, no need to think about what was done before." It's not that our past life isn't significant, that it doesn't matter to Jesus. It is, rather, that our sins over which we so often brood are gone, wiped away, when we take them to the Lord with repentant hearts in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Compared to the ocean of his mercy, they are like a drop of water!

This is a great consolation for us sinners! Our Saviour isn't interested as much in our sins as he is in us. When the scribes and Pharisees brought to Jesus the woman they'd caught in the act of adultery, Jesus didn't for a moment entertain their accusations. He didn't see this as an opportunity to pile on and condemn her with them but to save her and to bring into her life something new, a life about which sin was no more.

So, as we approach holy week, let's turn our focus to the Lord. Let's turn to him with repentant hearts, yes, but let us not allow our sins to get in the way of the new work he wants to do in us this Easter by making our relationship with him all about us and our sins. He does not hold our sins against us, but casts them behind his back, seeking to draw us to himself and to make something new.

GOSPEL: Jn 8:1-11

Jesus went to the Mount of Olives. At daybreak he appeared in the Temple again; and as all the people came to him, he sat down and began to teach them.

The scribes and Pharisees brought a woman along who had been Caught committing adultery; and making her stand there in full view of everybody, they said to Jesus, 'Master, this woman was caught in the very act of committing adultery, and Moses has ordered us in the Law to condemn women like this to death by stoning. What have you to say?' They asked him this as a test, looking for something to use against him. But Jesus bent down and started writing on the ground with his finger. As they persisted with their question, he looked up and said, 'If there is one of you who has not sinned, let him be the first to throw a stone at her. Then he bent down and wrote on the ground again. When they heard this they went away one by one, beginning with the eldest, until Jesus was left alone with the woman, who remained standing there. He looked up and said, 'Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?' 'No one, sir,' she replied. 'Neither do I condemn you,' said Jesus 'go away, and don't sin any more."

## CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

PART TWO: THE CELEBRATION OF THE CHRISTIAN MYSTERY SECTION TWO THE SEVEN SACRAMENTS OF THE CHURCH CHAPTER TWO THE SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Article 4

III. The Conversion of the Baptized

1427 Jesus calls to conversion. This call is an essential part of the proclamation of the kingdom: "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent, and believe in the gospel."<sup>16</sup> In the Church's preaching this call is addressed first to those who do not yet know Christ and his Gospel. Also, Baptism is the principal place for the first and fundamental conversion. It is by faith in the Gospel and by Baptism<sup>17</sup> that one renounces evil and gains salvation, that is, the forgiveness of all sins and the gift of

1428 Christ's call to conversion continues to resound in the lives of Christians. This second conversion is an uninterrupted task for the whole Church who, "clasping sinners to her bosom, (is) at once holy and always in need of purification, (and) follows constantly the path of penance and renewal."18 This endeavor of conversion is not just a human work. It is the movement of a "contrite heart," drawn and moved by grace to respond to the merciful love of God who loved us first. 19

1429 St. Peter's conversion after he had denied his master three times bears witness to this. Jesus' look of infinite mercy drew tears of repentance from Peter and, after the Lord's resurrection, a threefold affirmation of love for him.<sup>20</sup> The second conversion also has a communitarian dimension, as is clear in the Lord's call to a whole Church: "Repent!"21

St. Ambrose says of the two conversions that, in the Church, "there are water and tears: the water of Baptism and the tears of repentance."22



## **UPDATED COVID-19 ADVICE**

MASKS - will no longer be mandatory. However, masks are still strongly encouraged where you cannot maintain a safe distance from others.

**SINGING** - both the choir and congregation can sing.

**SOCIAL GATHERINGS** - are now permitted.

NSW QR CODE AND RECORD KEEPING - check-in using the NSW QR Code and record keeping for attendees is no longer required.

**DENSITY LIMITS** - no more density limits.

#### Self-isolation rules

There are changes to self-isolation rules that affect household contacts. If a household contact tests positive to COVID-19, you and the COVID-positive person must self-isolate for 7 days. Have a test as soon as possible and again on day 6. If all tests are negative, you can leave isolation after 7 days. You don't need to repeat self-isolation if another person in your household tests positive in the 14 days after you finish self-isolating. If another person in your household tests positive for COVID-19 more than 14 days after you've self-isolated, you'll have to self-isolate again for 7 days.

#### Updated COVID-19 testing advice

If you're at higher risk of severe illness from COVID-19, NSW Health recommends you get a PCR (nose and throat swab) test at a testing clinic when required, as they are most

There are treatments available that can only be prescribed in the early stages of infection, you just need to see your doctor.

We sincerely thank you for understanding, and for playing your part in keeping our community safe.




