# Doing something with Jesus

Jesus has ascended into heaven. What shall we do? Shall we wait and see what will happen or shall we do something?

In commemorating the Ascension of Jesus into Heaven, our liturgy presents to us three realities of our faith that help us discern what we shall do.

Firstly, looking at the Divinity of Jesus, the Ascension assures us of our salvation. It is in the articles of our faith that Jesus ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. Jesus shares fully the nature of God with the Father. Jesus is our God and Saviour. Therefore, we can do something by praying to Jesus and asking Him to supply our needs. We pray to Him, "do not bring us to the test but deliver us from all evil".

Secondly, the Ascension prompts us to imitate Jesus. Jesus is giving us hope as He said, "I will go ahead of you, in my Father's house there are plenty of rooms, I will prepare a place for you and I will come back to take you with me so that where I am, there you will also be. Yet, imitation of Jesus entails suffering and sacrifice. St Peter said, it is better to suffer for doing what is right and good than doing what is evil and wrong. Therefore, our imitation of Jesus is to do what is good and avoid anything that is evil.

Lastly, the Ascension allows us to share in the mission of Jesus. This is the message of today's gospel, "Go to the whole world and baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit and teach them my commandments". It is, therefore, our mission to bring Jesus to others and teach them how to love.

Three things therefore, that we shall and can do to meaningfully celebrate the Ascension of Jesus into Heaven: Pray to Jesus, Imitate Jesus and Share Jesus and His love.

Have a Blessed and Meaningful Feast!

THE SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

X. Indulgences

In the Communion of Saints

**1474** The Christian who seeks to purify himself of his sin and to become holy with the help of God's grace is not alone. "The life of each of God's children is joined in Christ and through Christ in a wonderful way to the life of all the other Christian brethren in the supernatural unity of the Mystical Body of Christ, as in a single mystical person."85

1475 In the communion of saints, "a perennial link of charity exists between the faithful who have already reached their heavenly home, those who are expiating their sins in purgatory and those who are still pilgrims on earth, between them there is, too, an abundant exchange of all good things."86 In this wonderful exchange, the holiness of one profits others, well beyond the harm that the sin of one could cause others. Thus recourse to the communion of saints lets the contrite sinner be more promptly and efficaciously purified of the punishments for sin.

**1476** We also call these spiritual goods of the communion of saints the Church's treasury, which is "not the sum total of the material goods which have accumulated during the course of the centuries. On the contrary the 'treasury of the Church' is the infinite value, which can never be exhausted, which Christ's merits have before God. They were offered so that the whole of mankind could be set free from sin and attain communion with the Father. In Christ, the Redeemer himself, the satisfactions and merits of his Redemption exist and find their effficacy."87

1477 "This treasury includes as well the prayers and good works of the Blessed Virgin Mary. They are truly immense, unfathomable, and even pristine in their value before God. In the treasury, too, are the prayers and good works of all the saints, all those who have followed in the footsteps of Christ the Lord and by his grace have made their lives holy and carried out the mission the Father entrusted to them. In this way they attained their own salvation and at the same time cooperated in saving their brothers in the unity of the Mystical Body."88



#### SAFE PARISHES WEEK 2023.

#### Safeguarding Mandatory Training is Due Now!

Are you new to Parish Ministry this year and have not completed your Safeguarding Training? Are you an existing volunteer and have not yet completed your 6 points of mandatory Safeguarding Training?

Under the Children's Guardian Act 2019 and the NSW Child Safe Standards <u>all</u> volunteers in parish ministry are Mandatory Reporters and are required to have completed their Safeguarding Training. The Office of the Children's Guardian expects all volunteers in parish ministry have now met this Standard.

In the Diocese of Parramatta we have a zero tolerance of abuse. We therefore commit to keeping children safe as well as all adults at risk.

You are now required to register for the Mandatory 6 points of Safeguarding Training to complete Cycle 1: Register for the Mandatory Training during Safe Parishes Week on:


